

Short Bio:

**Ignasi Carrió MD FEBNM FESC FRCP
Emeritus Professor of Medicine (Nuclear Medicine), Autonomous University of
Barcelona**

Ignasi Carrió was born in Manresa (Catalonia) in 1950 where he received primary education. He followed medical studies at the University of Barcelona where he graduated as MD in 1973. He followed a Residency program in Oncology at Hospital Sant Pau, Barcelona 1973-77. Obtained a PhD in Nuclear Medicine at the Autonomous University of Barcelona in 1981. Post-doctoral studies at the Department of Radiology, Harvard Medical School. Fellow, Nuclear Medicine Division, Massachusetts General Hospital. Boston 1982-83. His professional Board Certifications include, Spanish Board of Nuclear Medicine, European Board of Nuclear Medicine, Certification Council of Nuclear Cardiology (US).

His professional career in Nuclear Medicine has developed at Hospital de Sant Pau, Barcelona, where he founded the Department of Nuclear Medicine in 1984 and was its Director until 2020. His academic career has developed at the Autonomous University of Barcelona where he became Full Professor of Radiology and Nuclear Medicine in 1997 and is now Emeritus Professor of Medicine (Nuclear Medicine) since 2020.

His main research and scientific activities have been in Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging, in particular in the fields of Cardiovascular Medicine and Oncology. Scientific publications include over 300 peer reviewed articles and 6 books. Prof. Carrió has been recipient of many grants funded by national and international bodies including the European Commission. He has acted as expert evaluator and advisor of Universities and major international bodies in the field of Medical Imaging. Prof. Carrió is a sought after speaker, who has given lectures and participated in panels and scientific events on Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging all over the world. Many of his trainees and fellows are currently holding leading positions in departments in different countries around the world.

Prof. Carrió was President of the European Association of Nuclear Medicine (2005-2006) after holding different society responsibilities over the years, including that of Congress President in 1999. He became Honorary Member of the EANM in 2019. Prof. Carrió is Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (UK) and of the European Society of Cardiology. Among other activities related to Nuclear Medicine, he was President of the Spanish Society of Nuclear Medicine (1993-1995) and has served in many leading positions of professional societies.

Prof. Carrió has been Editor in Chief of the European Journal of Nuclear Medicine (2004-2018), and is associate Editor or a Board member of most premier medical imaging journals.

Prof. Carrió, currently Professor Emeritus, keeps doing research in nuclear medicine and molecular imaging at the Research Institute of the Hospital Sant Pau. Ignasi Carrió lives in Alella with his wife Rosa, they have been married for 40 years and they enjoy the family life with three grown-up children and a granddaughter and the company of the many friends when they wish to visit. He tries to combine enjoying the good things in life with supporting nuclear medicine and its scientific community.
